Q: What is Knight Lights?

A: A new town wide celebration of art on Sunday, January 25th from 4 to 7 pm. Residents will light luminary bags, create designs with those lights, and illuminate a wintry night! The event is designed as a benefit for the North Andover Schools Enrichment Council, a non-profit organization that works collaboratively with the public schools in North Andover to bring high-quality art, music and science performers and educators to the schools.
